SAMPLE TRIP PROGRAM

- Meeting at the specified place and welcoming the group by the guide. Departure from Warsaw in the morning.
- Transfer to Oświęcim (approx. 3.5-4 hours)
- Guided tour of the **Auschwitz-Birkenau Former German Nazi Concentration and Extermination Camp** (approx. 3.5 hours)
- Transfer to a restaurant in the Oświęcim area for lunch
- Return journey to Warsaw
- End of the trip in the evening

COACH TRANSPORT

Our transport partner is **Ibatur**, a company based in Białystok with a branch in Warsaw. We have been cooperating with them for many years. The company operates a modern fleet and employs professional and experienced drivers.

The coach used for the trip will have between 57 and 69 seats. For the comfort of participants, we aim to fill the coach to a maximum of 90-95% capacity.

Each coach is equipped with air conditioning, a toilet, and 230V power sockets or USB ports.



STAFF & CARE

TOUR LEADER

Throughout the entire trip, the group will be accompanied by a dedicated tour leader. Their role extends beyond logistics and supervision - they provide ongoing support, clear communication, and coordination throughout the day.

The tour leader serves as liaison between participants, local partners, and your company. Thanks to detailed knowledge of the itinerary and prior arrangements, the tour leader ensures a smooth flow of the trip and participant comfort, minimising the risk of unforeseen or unpleasant situations.

LOCAL GUIDE

The guided tour at the Auschwitz-Birkenau Memorial is led by a licensed museum educator, officially employed by the Memorial.

With extensive historical knowledge and professional sensitivity, the guide presents the history of this place in a respectful, informative, and impactful manner. Many guides come from families with direct survivor histories, offering deeply personal perspectives rooted in authentic testimony.
